

Terms and Conditions

"Stichting Nyenrode Fonds" (Further in text referred to as - "We" or "Nyenrode Foundation") is committed to allowing, protecting and respecting both your privacy and generosity.

This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Certain definitions set out in our Terms also apply in this policy. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it. By visiting <https://chairs.nyenrode.nl/> you are accepting and consenting to the practices described in this policy.

1. Donation Policy

Donation amount information: your donation amount remains confidential and will never be publicly disclosed. You may also chose to be not publicly seen in the infographics of the platform by selecting it in the donations process.

Cancellations: the donations made on the site and transferred to the fund have no kind of cancellation or refund.

Invoicing: each donor, after we receive a confirmation from Paymill on a successful transaction, receives an automatically generated receipt for the donation to the provided email address.

2. Privacy Policy

Information we collect from you

We collect and process the following data about you:

Information you give to us. You provide us with information by filling in a donation form on our site <https://chairs.nyenrode.nl/> (the Site). This includes the amount of donation, your first name, last name, e-mail, company (optional), country, photo (optional) and your quote, that will be displayed on an auditorium chair. You can choose whether your provided

information will or will not be visible in the public summary of the donors, while the amount donated will not be publicly disclosed.

Your financial information

Paymill processes all of the transactions on the Site and Paymill is the only party who sees your credit card information. Neither Nyenrode Foundation nor anyone else can view or has access to your credit card information.

Uses made of the information

We will use information held about you in the following ways:

Information that you provide to us. We will use this information:

- to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us and to provide you with the information and services that you request from us;
- to provide you with information about other services we offer that are similar to those that you have already registered for or enquired about;
- to notify you about changes to our services;
- to ensure that content from the Site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer.

Information that we collect about you. We will use this information:

- to administer the Site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
- to improve the Site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- to allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so;
- as part of our efforts to keep the Site safe and secure.

Information we receive from other sources. We may combine this information with information you give to us and information we collect about you. We may use this

information and the combined information for the purposes set out above (depending on the types of information we receive).

Disclosure of your information

We do not share your information with third parties, unless we need to comply with any legal obligation, or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Nyenrode Foundation, our sponsors, or others. This includes exchanging information with legal institutions for the purposes of fraud protection.

Where we store your personal data

All information you provide to us is stored on secure servers provided by a third party. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to the Site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

Your rights

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for statistical purposes. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data.
